

## GETTING YOUR CALIFORNIA BOATER CARD

## **CHECKLIST**

STEP ONE: COMPLETE AN APPROVED SAFETY COURSE	
	Get an Application ID through the official California Boater Card website.  During the application process, when you reach the "Proof of education" section, select "I have not taken Boating Safety education at this time."
	Use your Appliation ID to <u>register for the Drive A Boat USA boating safety course</u> .
	Take the NASBLA-approved boater safety course in a few hours, 100% online.
S	TEP TWO: TAKE THE TEST
	Score at least 80% to pass. Don't wrorry, it's an open-book test.
	If you don't pass, you can review tricky topics on the <u>Drive A Boat USA blog</u> or repeat the course.
	Take the test again until you pass. You have as many free retries as you need.
S	TEP THREE: APPLY FOR YOUR CALIFORNIA BOATER CARD  Make sure you have your Certificate of Completion from Drive A Boat USA
	Make sure you have your Certificate of Completion from Drive A Boat USA.
	Go back to the <u>California Boater Card website</u> , the same site you used to get your Application ID.
	Use your Application ID to log into your account.
	Navigate to the <i>Proof of Education</i> section of your application.
	Upload your Certificate of Completion.
	If you haven't already paid the \$10 fee, you'll need to do so at this point.
	Submit your updated application.
	Receive your temporary boater card by email, which you can use immediately.
	Wait for your official card: Your permanent California Boater Card will be mailed to you an should arrive within 60 days.
