

GETTING YOUR CALIFORNIA BOATER CARD

CHECKLIST

STEP ONE: COMPLETE AN APPROVED SAFETY COURSE
Get an Application ID through the official California Boater Card website. During the application process, when you reach the "Proof of education" section, select "I have not taken Boating Safety education at this time."
Use your Appliation ID to <u>register for the Drive A Boat USA boating safety course</u> .
☐ Take the NASBLA-approved boater safety course in a few hours, 100% online.
STEP TWO: TAKE THE TEST
_ STELL TWO. TAKE THE TEST
Score at least 80% to pass. Don't wrorry, it's an open-book test.
If you don't pass, you can review tricky topics on the <u>Drive A Boat USA blog</u> or repeat the course.
Take the test again until you pass. You have as many free retries as you need.
STEP THREE: RECEIVE YOUR CALIFORNIA BOATER CARD
Receive your temporary boater card by email, which you can use immediately.
Wait for your official card: Your permanent California Boater Card will be mailed to you and should arrive within 60 days.
